**Agenda Title**: For Possible Action: To make a recommendation to the Redevelopment Authority regarding the expenditure of \$30,000 from the FY 2018 Redevelopment Revolving Fund for design and construction of downtown gateway signage in conjunction with the South Carson Street *Carson City Gateway* project.

**Staff Summary:** Downtown gateway signage was identified in the Redevelopment Allocation Plan and budgeted in the FY 2018 budget for funding in the amount of \$30,000. The Public Works Department is currently in the design phase of the South Carson Street project, and identifying a location and design for downtown gateway signage should be completed concurrently with the street design. A recommendation is required from the RACC and approval by the Redevelopment Authority and Board of Supervisors is required to authorize the expenditure of the funds.

**Proposed Motion:** I move to recommend to the Redevelopment Authority approval of the expenditure of \$30,000 from the FY 2018 Redevelopment Revolving Fund for design and construction of downtown gateway signage in conjunction with the South Carson Street *Carson City Gateway* project.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The Public Works Department is currently in the design phase of the South Carson Street project, which includes design of South Carson Street from the I-580 interchange to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, where the recently-constructed downtown street improvements begin. The proposed funding would allow the design team to incorporate downtown gateway signage into the overall South Carson Street project design.

The design for the sign would include identifying an appropriate location for the sign, design of the sign structure and sign content, and any additional design elements associated with the sign such as landscaping or hardscape surrounding the sign, as may be applicable. It is anticipated that the design work would cost no more than approximately \$10,000, leaving at least \$20,000 for construction. Preliminary designs would be brought to the RACC for vetting, and additional funds could be sought to complete the project depending on the final sign design that is chosen.
