**Staff Summary:** In Fiscal Year ("FY") 2020, \$52,000 in redevelopment money was allocated to resurface the City pool decks and in FY 2019, \$252,996 in redevelopment money was allocated to make improvements in the Bob Boldrick Theater and \$44,754 was allocated to install a new sound system at Fuji Park. These improvements are now complete. Staff will present information regarding these improvements.

**DISCUSSION:**

The purpose of this item is to provide a report on projects that have been recently completed using redevelopment funds.

Pool Decks: Redevelopment Area 1

Redevelopment funding: \$52,000

Expensed: \$8,879.90

Replacement decking was completed in a section by section basis that will ensure that the facility did not have to be closed and negatively impact the public. Savings were realized by doing the project utilizing City staff.

Bob Boldrick Theater: Redevelopment Area 1

Redevelopment funding: \$252,996

Expensed: \$252,996

The Bob Boldrick Theater project included the replacement of the theater seats, new carpeting, painting, and replacement of the acoustic panes.

Fuji Park Sound System: Redevelopment Area 2

Redevelopment funding: \$44,754

Expensed: \$44,754

The Fuji Park Fairgrounds, located on Old Clear Creek Road, is a large venue used primarily for summer events. Due to continued problems with the old, outdated sound system, replacement of the current sound system at the Fairgrounds was identified as an urgent need in order to effectively accommodate events.
